Ernesto is a gentle and kind hearted friend whom I have known for the past eight years. He grew up in Venezuela (see map at right) with three brothers & one sister. His father abused his mother many times, and eventually Ernesto went to the police but, due to his father's political connections, they said she should be a better wife to her husband. On March 17, 1979, his father killed his mother and then turned the gun on himself. Ernesto was thirteen at the time and was furious for what his father had done. He later used drugs to kill the pain of hatred toward his father. However, at a Youth With a Mission (YWAM) training school in San Juan, Puerto Rico in 1986 Ernesto forgave his father and God changed his life.



Ernesto met Christine who was from California in 1987 and they were married on March 17, 1988, an incredible testimony of God restoring his life along with later having children, Jaymelee & Seth. They have served in Guatemala, Venezuela, and did church planting in California before coming to School of the Bible (SOTB) in 1992. Later he served on staff and coordinated the translation of all SOTB material into Spanish. Finally, Ernesto & Christine served in The Netherlands for one year and

just completed the Teacher for the Nations training school in Tyler, Texas. Ernesto & Christine are now headed to Nicaragua to present the Gospel that would transform all of society which would **bring liberty to mankind**. They plan to help start SOTB in Nicaragua (see map at left) in September 2005.
