“Return to Texas”

After serving in Washington D.C. with the Youth With a Mission (YWAM)-Tyler prayer team from April 2007 until December 2008, I made one trip between Cleveland, Ohio and Tyler, Texas in January of 2009 and lived with my parents for a few months. Finally, I returned to my house in March of 2009 and started the process of preparing to be managed by a property management company. After one month of working on the house, I decided to plug in to the ministry of YWAM-Tyler by working for the accounting department which processes mission



support for over 1,800 missionaries around the world. Later, I was transferred to do the morning bank run (**see picture at right**) and work with the Ministry Information Systems (MIS) department. MIS services dozens of lap-top and desk-top computers all over campus and keeps the internet service active so that the YWAM-Tyler ministry can function. YWAM in 2009 ministered to 45, 642 people on outreaches, in ten nations, trained approximately 400 people on campus, and led 401 people into a relationship with God.

“The End of The Great Commission?”

The fulfillment of the message of Jesus Christ will come to pass in the not too distant future. Last April in Kona, Hawaii, Youth With a Mission hosted a huge conference where Wycliffe Bible Translators, Campus Crusade for Christ, Trans World Radio, and the International Mission Board of the Southern Baptists met. These mission organizations reported that there has never been such great unity between the various different groups in bringing about the message of Jesus Christ. People from Wycliffe Bible Translators stated at the conference that at the current rate of recruitment into their organization and the technology being used to translate Scripture into a native language, that every tribe, tongue, and nation will have a New Testament Bible in their hands sometime between 2020 and 2025. Wycliffe Bible Translators, Youth With a Mission, Campus Crusade for Christ, and Trans World Radio have been working together to bring about the message of Jesus Christ for several years using the One Story Partnership.

One Story Partnership sends out teams to un-reached people groups and creates 25-40 chronological Bible stories which are told by the indigenous people. Many other mission agencies and churches using various different ministry techniques have targeted un-reached people groups with a population over 100,000. Six years ago 639 of these people groups had not heard about the message of Jesus Christ. Last December, it was reported that thanks to current mission efforts only 29 of these un-reached people groups with a population over 100,000 are left to be adopted. The adoption of a people group includes prayer and a strategy to get people on the ground to spread the message of Jesus Christ. One team from Youth With a Mission-Tyler left a few years ago for Asia and came back with a report that 11 churches were planted in one of these un-reached people groups. The indigenous Christians there continue the work of spreading the message of Jesus Christ and have 40 One Story Partnership story tellers (for more information www.ywamonestory.org).
