





Dear Family & Friends,

These first several months of 2017 saw the passing of some great men of God who gave input into my life at various times these past thirty-one years and I would like to honor them at this time.

The first of these men chronologically (far left above) was very wise in the Word of God. Pastor Jim became my pastor back in 1986 while I was attending the University of Toledo in Toledo, Ohio. He served in Africa for over sixteen years and had since pastored several churches in the US. He eventually moved to Florida. I am thankful for his friendship, wisdom, prayers, and keeping in touch through the years.

The second was Al McBryan who is from Canada. He taught in my training schools in 1993 about God's Nature and Character. Al not only taught in my schools but many other Youth With a Mission locations for over 25 years, impacting thousands of people. When I came back to Tyler in 2009, Al took any opportunity to play pool with a group of us young guys when he was in town. I also kept hockey cards he bought online and mailed to Tyler before he arrived to teach. The last time I communicated with Al, I helped him view Wedge's funeral service via YouTube. I am grateful for the time he spent with me and to be able to serve him as a friend.

The third was Gary Harke, the father of my dear friend Matthew whom I met soon after joining staff with Youth With a Mission-Tyler in 1994. Gary and I talked politics over the phone every now and then. The few times I visited him and his wife Ann, he was always encouraging and he gave me some prophetic words for the future several years ago.

The fourth, but not least was Wedge Alman (top right with me) who I talked about last year, regarding the importance of spending time with those who have been with the ministry for many years, before they pass on into eternity. When I could, I tried to sit and have lunch or dinner with Wedge in the cafeteria with the hope that he would tell me a story and he had many to tell. Wedge was sometimes referred to as the Billy Graham of Latin America because he was the father of Youth With a Mission in Latin America. Because of Wedge and his wife Shirley, hundreds of ministry locations have been started and thousands have been trained, discipled, and are now serving God all around the world. I am very thankful that I hung out on a regular basis with Wedge who had an incredible life story of God's goodness and faithfulness.


